I am delighted to share and formally celebrate the outstanding academic achievements of our Year 12 cohort in the 2025 ATAR examinations. These results represent an exceptional outcome for Al-Ameen College and reflect the collective commitment of our students, families, and staff to academic excellence, discipline, and high expectations.

### Exceptional ATAR Performance Across the Cohort

This year's results are particularly noteworthy not only for individual excellence, but for the strength and depth of achievement across the cohort:

- Over 25% of students achieved an ATAR above 90
- More than 60% of students achieved an ATAR above 80
- Our 2025 Year 12 Al Ameen College Graduates have surpassed all before them, producing an AVERAGE ATAR of 87.5% and with the University of Western Australia Bonus is realised at an exceptional 92.5%

### Outstanding Subject Achievement


A special acknowledgement must be given to:
